2004 Women's Tennis

Up Next:

The Tulane women's tennis team will travel to Athens, Ga., for the NCAA Tournament's Round of 16 this weekend. The Green Wave will face No. 23 Miami at noon on Thursday at Georgia's Henry Feild Stadium.

The Hurricanes reached the Round of 16 thanks to their 4-3 upset win over defending national champion and No. 1 seeded Florida. Should the Wave advance past Miami, they would face either No. 6 Southern Cal or No. 8 UCLA in the quarterfinals on Friday.

Thursday's contest marks Tulane's first ever berth in the Round of 16.

Tulane in the 2004 NCAA Tournament:

First Round vs. Richmond - The Green Wave posted a 4-0 win over Richmond in the first round at Oklahoma's Headington Tennis Center on Saturday, May 15. The Wave opened with wins on courts one and two to claim the opening doubles point before winning on courts three, four and six in singles play. **It marked the ninth time this season that Tulane has won a match without surrendering a point.**

Second Round vs. No. 20 Oklahoma - Tulane raced out to an early 3-1 lead but had to hold off a feisty Oklahoma team on Sunday, May 16, in the NCAA Tournament's second round. The Wave again won the doubles point, this time on courts two and three, before posting wins at No. 5 and No. 6 singles to claim a 3-1 advantage. But Oklahoma answered with a win at No. 2 singles to pull within 3-2 before the Wave put the match away with a win at No. 4 singles.

Two of a Kind:

Junior Nancy Kockott and freshman Darya Ivanov won both of their singles matches in Tulane's first and second-round showdowns over the weekend. Kockott played at No. 6 singles in both contests, while Ivanov was victorious in a pair of No. 4 singles matches.

Kockott also won both of her doubles matches with freshman partner Dorottya Magas at the No. 2 position.

Tulane Earns National Seed:

The Green Wave are one of 16 national seeds in the 2004 NCAA Championships. Though ranked 11th by the ITA, Tulane was given the No. 16 seed. Defending National Champion Florida is the tournament's No. 1 overall seed, with Stanford as the No. 2 seed. Texas, who Tulane defeated 5-2 in Austin earlier this season, is the 13th seed.

Record-Setting Wave:

Tulane has posted a 27-1 record this season, which includes a 17-1 record against ranked teams. The 27 wins are easily the most in school history. Overall, Tulane is 22-0 when winning the doubles point and 2-1 when losing the doubles point.

Title Wave:

Tulane claimed the 2004 Conference USA championship. It was the second straight league title, and third in the last four seasons, for the Green Wave, joining championships in 2001 and 2003.

Conference USA names its champion based solely on the league tournament. There is no C-USA regular season schedule. Tulane opened the 2004 tournament with a 5-0 win over Charlotte before recording a 4-1 win over Houston in the semifinals. The Wave then topped No. 25 TCU in the championship match for the second straight season.

Becoming a Habit:

This marks Tulane's second straight NCAA Tournament appearance and fifth overall. The Wave also had NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997, 1999, 2001 and 2003. The Wave lost in the first round in 1997 and 1999, and reached the second round in 2001 and 2003.

Wave's Wins Top NCAA Field:

Tulane has recorded the most wins among the 64-team NCAA Tournament field. The Wave's 27 victories are two better than Stanford and Northwestern who each have 25 victories this season.

20-20 Vision:

With this season's 27-1 record, Tulane has now posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time in school history. In addition to this season's 25-1 showing, last season's squad posted a 20-5 mark.

Kuhn Wins C-USA's Top Honor:

Sophomore Jenny Kuhn won her second straight Conference USA Player of the Year Award. She was also a first-team All-Conference USA selection for the second straight season and was named the Outstanding Singles Player of the 2004 C-USA Tournament.

Super Schumacher:

Tulane head coach David Schumacher was selected as the Conference USA Coach of the Year for the second straight season. It was Schumacher's third overall league Coach of the Year award (2001, 2003 and 2004) in his five seasons as the head coach at Tulane.

Eight is Enough:

Depth has played an important factor in Tulane's success this season. Each of the Wave's top eight players have been ranked in singles at some point this season, while six have seen time in the doubles listings.

The highlight came on April 6, when each of the Wave's top eight players were ranked in either singles or doubles (see chart below).

Seventh Heaven:

Of the 13 Conference USA Player of the Week awards handed out this season, Tulane captured seven of them, including six straight to end the regular season.

Sophomore Jenny Kuhn, who would be named league Player of the Year, won the award three times, while Maria Ivanov and Dorottya Magas each won the award twice (see list at right).

Tulane's Six Pack:

Tulane had six different players named to the All-Conference USA team this season. Junior Maria Ivanov joined Jenny Kuhn as a first team selection, while sophomore Julie Smekodub and freshmen Darya Ivanov and Dorottya Magas were second team choices. Junior Nancy Kockott was a third-team all-league honoree.

Interestingly enough, the two Tulane players who did not earn all-conference honors - Erika Valdes (8-1) and Ana Maria Saaibi (14-1) - were a combined 22-2 in singles play.

2003 Season Highlights

- ~ Tulane won the 2003 Conference USA championship.
- ~ Freshmen Jenny Kuhn and Julie Smekodub earned All-America honors in doubles from the ITA. Smekodub was also a singles All-American.
- ~ Kuhn and Smekodub won the 2002 ITA National Indoor Doubles title.
- ~ Tulane was the only team to win the doubles point from eventual national champion Florida during the NCAA Tournament, falling 4-1 to the Gators in the second round.
- ~ Jenny Kuhn was named 2003 C-USA Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year, while David Schumacher was chosen 2003 C-USA Coach of the Year. Ana Maria Saaibi was selected as the Outstanding Singles Player of the C-USA Tournament
- ~ The Green Wave ended the season ranked 28th by the ITA.
- ~ Jenny Kuhn, Julie Smekodub and Erika Valdes were named first-team All-Conference USA, while Ana Maria Saaibi (2nd team) and Maria Ivanov (3rd team) were also all-league choices.
- ~ Kuhn was chosen as the 2003 ITA Southwest Region Freshman of the Year, while Smekodub won the Region's Player to Watch award.

Record-Setting Freshman:

Newcomer Dorottya Magas set a Tulane school record for wins in a season by posting a 24-2 record this year. Those 24 wins top the previous best of 22 set by Anna Monhartova during the 1999 season.

Smekodub, Valdes Rejoin Line-Up:

Tulane was forced to play without the services of its two top players for much of the early part of the year, as both Julie Smekodub and Erika Valdes missed time with injuries.

Both returned to the line-up full time in the Wave's March 14 match against VCU. After slowly regaining her match fitness, Smekodub has rallied to win six straight completed matches. Valdes has also fared well since her return from injury, posting an 6-1 record since rejoining the squad.

At the time of their injuries, Smekodub was ranked 10th in singles by the ITA, while Valdes was listed 37th. They are the Wave's top two ranked players.

Tulane vs. the NCAA Field:

Heading into the NCAA Tournament, Tulane had played 11 teams in this season's field, and posted an 11-1 mark against them. The Green Wave own a pair of wins over TCU while also having victories over tournament teams South Alabama, Tulsa, Arizona, Texas, Texas-Arlington, LSU, Arizona State, Southern and Florida State. The Wave's lone loss to a tournament team, and indeed its only loss of the season, was a 4-3 setback at the hands of then-No. 14 Fresno State at the UNLV Tournament in late February.

Sister Act:

The Green Wave roster features a pair of sisters in Maria and Darya Ivanov. Though hailing from Adelaide, Australia, the duo were both born in Tashkent, Uzbekistan - which was part of the Soviet Union at the time.

Maria, a junior, has twice been a first-team All-Conference USA honoree (2002 and 2004) as well as a third-team choice (2003). She was also the C-USA Freshman of the Year in 2002.

Darya, a freshman, was a second-team All-Conference USA choice this season and is currently on an eight-match winning streak, which includes dual match singles wins in both the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament.
